Dr. Daniel Eisenberg is an Assistant Professor of Diagnostic Imaging at Thomas Jefferson University School of Medicine and a practicing radiologist in the Department of Radiology at the Albert Einstein Medical Center in Philadelphia, where he was a former member of the hospital ethics committee and currently sits on the IRB. He is also a noted lecturer in Jewish medical ethics, lecturing around the world, and serving as the medical ethics scholar-in-residence for the New England Institute for Jewish Studies in Jerusalem and for the Schlesinger Institute for Medical-Halachic Research. Dr. Eisenberg has published multiple medical ethics articles in both the scholarly and lay press, contributing to both secular and Jewish books and periodicals. His articles and chapters have appeared in *Beracha Le'Avraham*, *The Hadassah Jewish Family Book of Health and Wellness*, and *Global Viewpoints- Abortion* and periodicals and journals (such as *Cancer Investigation*, *Assia-Jewish Medical Ethics*, *the Jewish Press*, *The Jewish Observer*, and *Jlaw.com*). Dr. Eisenberg has also written over 30 Jewish medical ethics articles for *Aish.com*. Most recently, Dr. Eisenberg has developed the content for the web-based, human subject research instructional module in ethics and professionalism for the *American Board of Radiology*.
