WOMENS' TEHILLIM GROUP: Sunday mornings: Since our group's move to a new Sunday morning location, it seems appropriate to review the whys and hows of the Tehillim group. Our group is part of the organization Aneinu. Aneinu was started years ago by a woman, Shaindy Kappel, who acted upon observing the illnesses and suffering of so many in the Jewish community.

The concept of Aneinu is the following: Sefer Tehillim is divided into 24 booklets and groups of people nationally and beyond say Tehillim b'tzibur (in a group). The uniqueness and power of this group lies in the collective strengths of all the women gathered. Some of the women are veteran Tehillim sayers, others need more time to read the words while others use an English translation. Each woman takes a different pamphlet out of the 24 and says it silently, but in the presence of all the other women. There is no pressure to keep up because each woman recites her own chapters in her own style and at her own pace. Together, in an abbreviated amount of time, the group completes the entire Sefer Tehillim. A me'sheberach is said for the cholim in the St. Louis Jewish community after their names are read.
