Facing Adversity, Fostering Strength and Living Your Best Life – Thursday, March 4 at 10 am. Cost: Free

Dr. Leslie M. Gutman is Associate Professor in the Department of Clinical, Educational and Health Psychology and Director of the MSc Behaviour Change at University College London, England. Her book, *Resilience: A Jewish Guide to Facing Setbacks, Fostering Strength, and Living Your Best Life* (published by Mosaica Press), focuses on the major life tests that many of us face and the different strengths we can cultivate to boost resilience with dozens of practical resilience-building exercises. As we enter the second year of the COVID pandemic, can't we all do with a little help to continue to build up resilience?

Former St. Louisan, Dr. Morris Hartstein, is currently the Director of Ophthalmic Surgery at Shamir Medical Center, Tel Aviv University School of Medicine in Israel. Since visiting Ethiopia with his family to volunteer in 2014, he has made ten more trips, providing eye care to the poorest of the poor, training Ethiopian ophthalmologists and establishing a food program for over 500 malnourished children. Hear from Dr. Hartstein about the lifesaving work he has done and continues to do for so many in Ethiopia.
