"UNITED 4 NEW TREES OF LIFE": Young Israel of St. Louis is proud to join the worldwide "United 4 New Trees of Life" initiative, an effort to commemorate the victims of Oct 7 and eternalize their memory planting 12,000 new fruit trees in Israel in the western Negev region. Many of the farms in this area are on the verge of collapsing. Through this initiative we can help revitalize this area and create a lasting living legacy to the victims, 12,000 fruit trees that bring life and vitality in memory of the 1,200 victims of Oct 7.

All participants will share in the many mitzvot performed with these trees and their fruits such as orlah, teruma, ma'aser, and shmitta. The trees will be planted by observant farmers in Israel through Zo Artzeinu, an organization which has, to date, helped plant over half a million such trees throughout Israel.

Every donor will receive their own official colorful personalized certificate, suitable for framing, which can contain a dedication as well. As a Shul community, if we plant an orchard of 100+ trees, a personalized sign will be installed at the entrance of our orchard visible to all visitors.
